Most donated funds are used for scholarships, with only a small portion allowed for administrative or promotional costs.

Qualified Louisiana students



Students from households generally up to 250% of federal poverty guidelines



Students who meet the program's eligibility pathway requirements

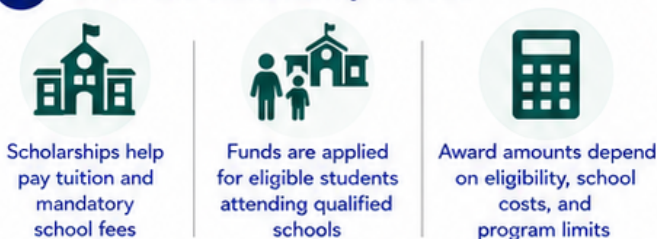


Students attending, or planning to attend, a qualified participating school

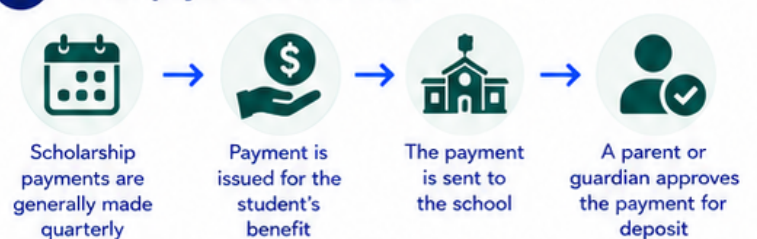
